 - Offer after school tutoring
 - Happy with the school
- Most of the Spanish comments were:
 - Happy with the school and what the school offers
 - Activities that include parents, English classes for parents
 - More sports
 - Bilingual programs

Actions that M. C. Riley will take in Response to Results

- The school informs parents about their right to request teacher qualifications through the school website as well as informing them at Back to School night and sending home a flyer.

- We have 4 staff members available to speak Spanish (at the front desk, a bilingual liaison, parent liaison and office)
- Latino families can participate in the Latino Literacy Project, a program that supports and instills the love of reading to parents and students by reading bilingual books.
- This year the school offers early morning enrichment programs and after school programs that include Art, Music, Technology, Chorus, Media, Lego League, Dance, Chess, Running and academic support.
- EAGLE After Hours is available to students grades K-5th, Monday through Friday.
